Declaration of Support for the Reproductive

Rights of People Living with HIV

As a care provider and ally to people living with HIV, I recognize the reproductive rights of all people. Upholding these rights require collaboration and support from across sectors.

## As a care provider, I commit to:

- Offering reproductive health counseling including birth control options, parenting choices, strategies to reduce HIV transmission based on up-to-date, accurate and values-neutral information.
- Approaching this counseling from a nonjudgmental approach and accounts for our sexual, gender, cultural, ethno-racial & religious diversity in beliefs and practices.
- 3 Ensuring my counselling considers issues such as parenting-related HIV Stigma and discrimination, a harm reduction approach related to substance use realities for families, and considerations for families who choose not to parent.
- Performing a clinical review of all medications to ensure safety in pregnancy.
- $(\,5\,)$  Facilitating access to cART at all life stages.

- 6 Supporting your preferred option for becoming a parent.
- 7 Facilitating access to fertility specialist who are informed about HIV when necessary.
- Supporting your right to make a fully informed decisions about exercising your reproductive rights. This includes full explanations of all medical procedures & risks, to choose or refuse the treatment modalities, to refuse to participate in research w/o jeopardizing our treatment.
- 9 Respecting your privacy and confidentiality.
- Being an ally in your journey related to your reproductive rights as a person living with HIV.
