





Steps for Testing with GetaKit



GetaKit is a study from the University of Ottawa that partners with local public health units across Ontario to offer **FREE** online assessments and lab-based testing for sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and HIV.

For most orders, your 'kit' will be digitally delivered to a testing lab of your choice. Orders with physical materials like swabs for HIV self-testing kits will be delivered to your address in discreet packaging.







In **Order testing**, you'll be guided through a series of questions to help determine what tests you'll be recommended.







— How long do results take?

Test	Turnaround Time
Urine	1 - 2 business days
Oral / Rectal Swabs	4 - 5 business days
Blood	3 - 7 business days
